Our private eye examination incorporates a full history and symptoms; an internal examination of the eye plus an external examination using the latest Topcon photographic digital slit lamp. A full refraction will be carried out to determine your personalized prescription. In addition all those over 40 will have their intra-ocular pressures recorded. Following this comprehensive examination, advice will be given as to the presenting history symptoms.

NHS Sight Test.....*Free, paid for by the NHS*

Our *free* NHS sight test consists of a full refraction and an external review of the eye. As the NHS funding only covers you for brief basic sight testing, it is suggested for NHS patients to upgrade for a full examination.

Examination Supplements

NHS upgrade to Full Examination.....£5.30

By upgrading to a NHS full examination you will be examined on the latest Topcon photographic digital slit lamp. This cutting-edge instrumentation enables our professionals to take a detailed look and be able to record any abnormalities of the eye.

Digital Retinal Photography.....£25.00

Sometimes situations may arise where a digital retinal photograph may be required; an example of this is diabetic retinopathy. This may entail the use of eye drops to dilate the eye. Pictures will be taken and saved on the Topcon image *i-base* software where they can be archived for future reference.

Computerized Visual Field Analysis.....£10.00

This comprehensive visual field analysis is carried out by the use of our new Henson 8000. After the analysis your results will be explained by a Senior Optometrist and stored on our practice software for future reference – a copy of the visual field analysis can be made available.
